

commuter rail and high cost of parking. This high-speed catamaran/passenger ferry service operates seasonally from May 28, 21010 through October 31, 2010 between Salem and two locations in Boston—Long Wharf and the World Trade Center in the Seaport District area.

The City of Salem and the MBTA will continue to offer the flexible pass program where MBTA monthly passes will be accepted on the Salem Ferry services. The monthly MBTA Zone 5—8 Commuter rail will be honored as a valid fare on the Salem Ferry for weekday commuter trips, listed below. For your convenience, Salem Ferry tickets can be purchased online or at the ferry dock. 2010 Salem Ferry schedule below.

The City of Salem owns one 149-passenger high catamaran named Nathaniel Bowditch, which it leases to the private ferry company, Water Transportation Alternatives (WTA). WTA docks the Salem Ferry at Blaney Street in Salem, MA and there is plenty of parking at this location (near the Hawthorne Marina)
